

Privacy Notice

This Privacy Notice explains how Koganei Maru Ltd. (the “Company”, “we”, “us”, or “our”) collects, uses, discloses, and otherwise processes personal information in connection with our websites, including www.pascal.trade and other websites we own and operate that link to this Privacy Notice (collectively, the “Sites”) and the related content, platform, services, products, and other functionality offered on or through our online services (collectively, the “Services”).

OUR COLLECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

We collect personal information in connection with your visits to and use of the Service. This collection includes information that you provide in connection with the Service, information from third parties, and information that is collected automatically such as through the use of Cookies (as defined below) and other technologies.

Personal Information Collected from Individuals

We may collect the following personal information submitted to us by individuals through the Services:

- **Account Information.** When you create or maintain a Company account, we may collect your email address, and account information (pubkey, etc). We use this information to register and administer your account, provide the Services, communicate with you, and deliver customer support.
- **Fiat Funding, Payment, and Banking Information.** If relevant to your use of the Site, for the purpose of facilitating deposits, withdrawals, and other fiat-based transactions through our partners, we may collect bank-account details (such as account and routing numbers), card information, bank-account ownership and verification results, and payment or settlement metadata.
- **Communications Information.** When you contact us, including through email, support channels, web forms, or similar means, we may collect your name, contact information, the content of your communications, attachments you provide, and related metadata (e.g., timestamps, device information). We use this information to respond to inquiries, provide customer support, improve the Services, and maintain records for compliance and operational purposes.
- **Marketing and Newsletter Information.** If you subscribe to marketing communications, we may collect your email address, marketing preferences, and interaction data related to such communications. We use this information to send updates about the Company's products and services. You may opt out of marketing emails at any time, but you cannot opt out of service-related communications.
- **Event, Webinar, and Program Information.** If you register for Company-sponsored events or programs, we may collect registration details, contact information, participation data, and related metadata. We use this information to administer events, communicate with participants, and improve future programs.

- **User Content.** When you upload or transmit content-including text, images, documents, audio, video, data, or other materials-through the Services or support channels, we may collect that User Content and associated metadata (such as creation time and file information). We use this information to provide the Services, enforce our Terms (as defined below), assist with investigations, support security and compliance efforts, and protect our rights and users.
- **Employment Application Information.** If you apply for a position with the Company, we may collect your contact information, demographic information (where permitted), educational and employment history, application materials, interview information, references, and any other information you choose to provide. We use this information to evaluate applications, manage the recruitment process, and comply with applicable employment and legal requirements.

Personal Information Automatically Collected

As is true of most digital platforms, we and our third-party providers may also collect device, browsing, and usage information automatically, such as internet protocol (IP) address, operating system, browser type, referring URLs, and other information about interacting with our Services. Where permitted by your device settings or with your explicit permission, we may collect precise geolocation data from your device, as well as device-level identifiers and telemetry used to support security, fraud detection, and transaction routing.

1. OUR USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

We may use personal information we collect to:

- Deliver and maintain the Services;
- Authenticate your account credentials;
- Communicate with users, and enable users to communicate with each other;
- Engage in marketing and advertising;
- Provide customer support;
- Conduct research and analytics;
- Improve and customize our Services;
- Detect and mitigate safety, fraud, and security threats;
- Enforce terms (including our Terms of Service at <https://app.pascal.trade/terms.pdf> (the “**Terms**”)), protects rights, and support compliance;
- For any other lawful purpose, or other purpose that you consent to or for which you provide your information.

Where you choose to contact us, we may need additional information to fulfill the request or respond to inquiries. We may provide you with additional privacy-related information where the scope of the inquiry/request and/or personal information we require fall outside the scope of this Privacy Notice. In that case, the additional privacy notice will govern how we may process the information provided at that time.

2. OUR DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

We disclose personal information in the following ways:

- **Affiliates.** We may share personal information with the Company's corporate affiliates.
- **Service Providers.** We share personal information with service providers that host our systems, store data, secure our infrastructure, provide authentication tools, operate logging or monitoring systems, support incident-response workflows, provide analytics, provide marketing services, document-processing vendors, cloud-based productivity tools, audit and accounting partners, and employment-application processing systems, and enable customer support and user communication. These providers process such information solely on our behalf, and we do not permit these providers to use personal information for their own independent commercial purposes, and the Company does not "sell" personal information. For card-program and payment-card transactions, we rely on PCI-DSS-compliant payment processors who receive your card information directly and provide us only with a token. We do not store full payment-card numbers on our systems.
- **Business Transactions or Corporate Events.** We may disclose or transfer personal information to third parties in connection with contemplated or actual mergers, acquisitions, financings, divestitures, reorganizations, or sales of company assets. Personal information may also be disclosed or transferred in the event of insolvency, bankruptcy, or receivership.
- **Legal Obligations, Compliance, and Protection of Rights.** We may disclose personal information to legal advisors, regulators, law enforcement, or other governmental authorities as required to: comply with laws or lawful processes; satisfy reporting obligations under financial-crime and sanctions laws; detect, prevent, or respond to fraud or unauthorized activity; protect the Company's rights or property; protect the rights, safety, and security of users or others; or enforce our agreements and policies.
- **With Your Consent or Direction.** We may disclose personal information to third parties where you direct or consent to such disclosure. For example, if you authorize a connection between the Company and another service provider, or if you provide consent to publish testimonials or user-submitted content.

3. CONTROL OVER YOUR INFORMATION

You may control your information in the following ways:

- **Email Communications Preferences:** You can stop receiving promotional email communications from us by clicking on the "unsubscribe" link provided in such communications. You may not opt-out of service-related communications (e.g., account verification, transactional communications, changes/updates to features of the Services, technical and security notices).
- **Modifying or Deleting Your Information:** If you have any questions about reviewing, modifying, or deleting your information, you can contact us directly at support@pascal.trade. We may not be able to modify or delete your information in all circumstances, especially in relation to information on the blockchain.

4. CHILDREN'S PERSONAL INFORMATION

Our Services are not directed to, and we do not intend to, or knowingly, collect or solicit personal information from children under the age of 16. If an individual is under the age of 16, they should not use our Services or otherwise provide us with any personal information either directly or by other means. If we learn that any personal information we collect has been provided by a child under the age of 16, we will promptly delete that personal information.

Cookies and Similar Technologies Used on Our Services

A cookie is a small file placed on the hard drive of your computer. When you visit our Site, use our Services, we and certain business partners and vendors may use cookies and other tracking technologies (collectively, "Cookies"). We use Cookies to recognize you as a customer, to customize the Services, other content and advertising, to measure the effectiveness of our promotions, to perform a wide range of analytics, to mitigate risk and prevent potential fraud, and to promote trust and safety across our Services.

Most browsers are set to accept cookies by default. You can remove or reject cookies. However, certain Services in the Services are only available through the use of Cookies. Tracking Technologies Used in Our Emails

Our emails may contain tracking pixels that identify if and when you have opened an email that we have sent you, how many times you have read it and whether you have clicked on any links in that email. This helps us measure the effectiveness of our marketing email campaigns, make the emails we send to you more relevant to your interests and to understand if you have opened and read any important administrative emails we might send you. Most popular email clients will allow you to block these pixels by disabling certain external images in emails.
